It is with much happiness that we received all the COVID test results from our testing on 1.18.2021 and all staff and residents tested are negative. What great news.

On Tuesday, the residents (those on the LTC units and have been given consent) and staff of St. Ann and Bishop Gendron received the COVID vaccine. For many of us, this was our second and final dose, for some this was this first. The last dose will be administered on February 9th.

I am pleased to report that we were 90.3% complaint with staff receiving the vaccine. While we are not able to mandate this vaccine, this high rate of agreement to willingly receive this vaccine simply goes to show the determination of the St. Ann team to put a halt to the spread of COVID.

The Strafford County positivity rate remains very high- at 17.3%. This continues to prevent our ability to offer inside visitation outside compassionate care visits. I so appreciate your continue support and understanding of these restrictions for the continued safety of our residents and community.
