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Good afternoon,

It brings me joy to report that we have yet again completed another round of COVID testing and all staff and residents tested on 1.25.2021 came back today and we are all NEGATIVE.

The state and more specifically, Strafford County continues to show high positivity COVID rates within New Hampshire. Stafford County is at 16.7%. See the table below reports the high rates by county. As a reminder- as long as the county positivity rate remains greater than 10%- we will not be accepting any visitors into the facility with the exception of compassionate care visits. IF we feel this is needed and would be beneficial for any residents- we will (and have) reached out to see about coordinating these visits through Social Services.
